WHO:

Students, 15-19 years old, that are interested in foreign travel, learning about other cultures, meeting new friends and willing to try new things that will enable them to fully experience life in another country. These students don't need to be related to a Rotarian but can be a son, daughter, grandchild, niece, neighbor, Interactor or RYLA student as long as they live in District 5220.

WHERE:

Students will go to the Brittany area of France (Rotary District 1650), which includes the beautiful beaches, amazing Monasteries Museum's and History.

WHEN:

July and August 2024. The exact dates will be arranged by the host families.

WHY:

Introduce the student to the international community and build lifetime friendships. It will "super charge" the student's education and their personal growth.

Round-trip airfare France:	\$2,000 (estimated)
Travel Insurance:	\$125 (estimated)
Rotary Activity Fee:	\$550 (<i>Frequently paid by the sponsoring Rotary Club</i>)
All Travel Documents:	Passports, etc
Personal Spending Money	\$200 + suggested
